FAQ'S

Is there anything I require before I submit an application?

Before you start you will need;

- ▶ A National Police Clearance that is less than six months old. If you do not have one you can visit your local post office or click on the link below to obtain one online <http://auspost.com.au/police-checks.html>
- ▶ Identification - diver's licence, current passport or birth certificate.

What if I have a conviction recorded on my NPC?

Criminal history is not necessarily a barrier to volunteering with St John and is always assessed on a case by case basis. You may be contacted to clarify information. Confidentiality is assured at all times.

What if I have a pre-existing medical condition?

We may require some more information, depending on the condition disclosed. If this is the case, St John will request, via email, for you to have your GP sign a clearance.

You can expect your application to be processed as quickly as possible by NPC upon receipt of your documentation.
